Noncommissioned Officers (NCOs) within the 51C MOS perform the vital task of providing procurement support for any supply or service a unit might require and serve as business advisors to supported unit commanders; supporting their mission at the tactical point of need. The 51C MOS was established in December 2006 to meet the Army's increasing need for contracting NCOs on the battlefield to support the warfighter, making contracting NCOs a critical asset.
